



2. Principles of VJU

- To become University of International Standard: High-quality education as the same as top-level universities in Japan
- Development of Leader: Human resource education to enhance the development of Vietnam and to promote the good relationship of both countries
- Practical education is based on Japanese technologies and experiences in order to develop High level professionals and engineers
- Hub of mutual understandings between both countries
- Respect for the initiatives(cooperation) of each university
- Lectures and human resource training is in Japanese language basically (and combined usage of English)

3. Distinguished Features of VJU

- Emphasis on education of Liberal Arts(basic education)
- Practical attractive lectures/seminars of prominent professors and executives of companies
- Education/research of community-forming-oriented by emphasizing the importance of human connection
- Taking use of various human and functional networks between the universities of both countries, VJU will prepare splendid services to meet various needs of students
- Japanese-style upbringing of human resource and supports for job-findings
- Advanced Environments to learn Japanese language
- Thorough-going of English education and promotion of global education
- Advanced education/research environments of facilities, ICT environment and curriculums, etc.





(Development of various leaders, advanced practical engineers and professionals through Industry-Academia-Government cooperation)



7 VJU characteristics: facilities

- Headquarter (including training facilities, exhibition spaces(Museum), etc.): VNU
- Undergraduate school and Faculty Buildings: HHTP⇒VNU
- Buildings of Graduate school: HHTP⇒VNU
- Satellite campus: in Hanoi central City (inside VNU, Hanoi campus (proposed area))
- Library (available for 24 hours, including digital library): VNU
- Student Exchange Center (Japan-Vietnam restaurant, commons, small-to-medium-sized convention hall and shop etc...): HHTP, VNU and Satellite campus
- Industry-academia collaboration center (Internship, Training center): HHTP
- Start-up(venture) promotion center (Incubator Center): HHTP
- VJU Hall (lecture hall, site for large scale event and conference): VNU, Satellite campus
- Science Museum: HHTP
- Industrial Museum (A practical science-oriented): HHTP
- School playground, Sports center: HHTP、VNU
- Long-term accommodation for Researchers, scholars, instructors and Student dormitory(etc...): HHTP、VNU

(note)HHTP: located at HoaLac High-tech park, VNU: located at relocation area of VNU, Hanoi. RED: mainly for students, Black: mainly industry-academia related.

8. Schedule of the establishment of VJU

Establishment In 2016

VJU—The Graduate School of Sustainability (Master Course) is supposed to be open.

- -The start of preparation course
- -The start of practical human resources training program
- -Facilities: Rent in Hanoi City central
- -Facilities under construction in Hoa Lac and Hanoi city central
- -Students: Approximately 160 persons (Master course).
- -Training of Japanese Language, practical human resources development

Around 2020

Establishment of VJU with the full doctoral course & with faculties for undergraduates,

- -Increasing subjects/researchgroups,
- -Establishments of Research Institutes & Industry-Academia Collaboration Facilities,
- -Extension of Human Resource Development Programs & Training courses,
- -Hosting of Forums & Symposiums,
- -Facilities: Campus In Hoa Lac, & Satellite Campus in the Hanoi central,
- -Students:1000~2000 persons including 700 post-graduates.

Around 2025

Establishment of 4 schools/faculties (2 in Natural-Sciences, 2 in Humanities) in VJU.

- -Extension of Research Institutes & Industry-Academia Collaboration Facilities,
- -Extension of Human Resource Development Programs & Training courses,
- -Hosting of Forums & Symposiums,
- -Facilities: VNU Campus & HHTP Campus In Hoa Lac & Satellite Campus in the Hanoi central,
- -Students: About 6000 persons including 2400 post-graduates,
- -A lot of staff & trainees in Research Institutes, etc. & Specialists/Experts joining Human Resource Development activities.

9 Issues raised by Japanese Government

- 1. Request of "ODA-Yen loan" by Vietnamese Government.
- 2. Ensure VJU positions and suitable campus location: as a symbol of Japan-Vietnam partnership, University of International level experts and leading researcher gathers.
- 3. Continuously of VNU management (management, finance and get good students, etc...): as a "University of Vietnam" under the VNU Hanoi, which is established in cooperation with Japan-Vietnam both countries.
- 4. Clarification of the dispatch of instructors and researchers from Japanese universities: the effective management through industry-academia-government cooperation and consortium formation by leading universities of Japan.
